A Description of the ABC Services

<u>A Personal Journey to the Nativity</u> by St. John's, Wauwatosa, is a scripted drama for 2 characters that tells the biblical account of Jesus' birth through the eyes of Anna, a shepherd's younger sister. The dialogue with her mother is a wonderful telling of the Gospel accounts and many prophecies.

<u>Advent Prayer Service</u> by Marilyn Miller is a celebration of Advent in lessons and songs. The narrative explains the traditional candles of the Advent wreath (Prophecy, Bethlehem, Angel, Shepherd, Christ) and includes readings, music and prayers.

<u>Anticipating His Presence</u> by St. John's, Wauwatosa is based on His "presence" (the gift of Jesus) rather than presents. The 10 gifts that are unwrapped in this scripted drama include: Jesus, Love, His Light & Word, Holy Spirit & Faith, Perfection, Forgiveness, Righteousness & Truth, Peace, Prayer, and Eternal Life.

<u>Good News of Great Joy for All People</u> by Naomi Schmidt focuses on the Good News that has come with the birth of the Savior, the Great Joy we receive with the Gospel message, and a reminder that these are for All People. It includes a bit of encouragement for evangelism and optional, brief skits, along with music, readings and prayers.

<u>Have a Mary Christmas</u> by Naomi Schmidt suggests several "Marys" that have a Christmas message. Mary of Bethany reminds us that only one thing is needed, Mary, the mother of Jesus reminds us to treasure Jesus and think about him, and Mary Magdalene reminds us that Jesus freed us from sin and enables us to serve him. Costumes optional.

Is There a Star in Your Eyes? by St. Andrews, Middleton, follows the theme of stars and includes Bethlehem's Star, the Star is Born, Star Search, Spread the Starlight, The Star in our Hearts, Watch the Star and The Star Still Shines. It includes an opening skit, readings and music.

<u>Keeping Christ in Christmas</u> by St. John's, Wauwatosa, is a dramatic setting of Christmas symbols and their meaning. It includes narratives on the Advent Wreath, Carols, Christmas Trees, the Nativity, Lights & Candles, Star, Angels, Christmas plants, Candy Canes, Bells, Cards, Food, Gifts & Wise Men, and colors.

Let Your Lights Appear by St. John's, Wauwatosa includes the traditional candles of the Advent Wreath and then includes new, alternative ways to think about the candles with a focus on letting the light of our faith shine at home, work, in our community and at church.

<u>Prepare My Heart, Lord Jesus</u> by Su Hanson follows the traditional candles of the Advent Wreath (Prophecy, Bethlehem, Angel, Shepherd and Christ candle) and closes with a Gathering Rite on Holy Baptism.

<u>**Take Me to the Manger**</u> by Tracy Hankwitz teaches us lessons from Christ's manger: A Glory to Gaze Upon, A Gift to Count Upon, A Comfort to Lean Upon, and A Hope to Draw Upon. It includes narratives, music selections, and poetry.

<u>The Light to Brighten Your Christmas</u> by Johanna Manke is a beautifully written program with a reminder of God's creation of light, the darkness of sin and the promised light of the Savior, readings about the Gospel illuminating a sin-darkened world, and a reminder that our light of faith shines in our life. It includes a confession of sins, narratives and responsive readings, suggested music and prayers. It also includes the lighting of a memory candle for those loved ones who have gone before us to dwell in heaven.

<u>The Time Has Come</u> by St. Andrews, Middleton recounts the "times" that have come: A Time for creation, a promise, confession, prophecy, a Savior, Good News, and Jesus' Return. It includes music selections, "In His Time" and "Soon and Very Soon" along with traditional Christmas music.

<u>Wait for the Lord</u> by Linda Gumm begins in the Garden of Eden and highlights the prophecies throughout the Old Testament and after the familiar Gospel accounts of Jesus' birth, and ends with an encouragement to keep watch for His return.
